She is skilled in crisis intervention, case management, written and oral reports, and coordinating program evaluations. Allison obtained a Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice and Sociology from Oakland University Honors College in 2019. She graduated from Michigan State University with a Master of Science in Law Enforcement Intelligence and Analysis. Allison is the founder of Oakland County Survivor to Thriver Initiative, Founding Member of the Michigan Ops Team Investigation Violent Exploitation (MOTIVE) and a board member of a local non-profit fighting human trafficking, Sparrow Freedom Project.
