## LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT & CEO

---

Dear Friends,  
Welcome to Common Ground's 2021 – 2022 Annual Report. It was a busy year for the agency as we significantly expanded our crisis services programs across the State of Michigan and locally in Oakland County.

In April, we opened our state-wide Behavioral Health Urgent Care program. This new addition to our continuum is a virtual/Telehealth offering staffed by clinicians and nurse practitioners. People can register online at [CommonGroundHelps.org](https://CommonGroundHelps.org) and be connected with these professionals in just minutes. While not a substitute for ongoing therapy, it does offer immediate help with issues such as depression, anxiety, extreme grief and even medication refills.

In July, the 988 initiative was launched across the nation. This three-digit number, similar to 911, offers callers immediate mental health crisis support. In Michigan, the Department of Health and Human Services contracts with Common Ground to answer the calls originating from 76 of the 83 Michigan counties. We are proud to be part of this effort and to date have already answered more than 167,000 calls!

The All for Oxford Resiliency Center opened in September of 2022. This center is staffed by professionally trained individuals giving residents, students, and others in the Oxford community a place to heal from the trauma of the tragic shootings at Oxford High School.

In Fall of 2021, Common Ground hosted our inaugural Celebration of Hope fundraising gala. One of the highlights of this event is the Kay White Legacy Award. Named after our board chair, 35-year volunteer, and initial honoree (Kay White), the award recognizes an individual or individuals who embody an inspirational spirit and selfless commitment in one or more of the following areas: leadership, fundraising, volunteerism, recruitment.

I hope you enjoy this review of our work and will continue to support our efforts. We can't do what we do without your help. Thank you for being part of the Common Ground family and helping us help others move from crisis to hope.

# FROM CRISIS

The Virtual Behavioral Health Urgent Care (BHUC) program launched in April 2022 to meet the growing demand of Michiganders who are seeking care for health conditions including anxiety, depression, panic attacks, as well as to provide mental health bridge medications.

Now when people need support, but aren't in an immediate crisis, they can connect with a licensed, master's level clinician without an appointment, 6 days a week, from the privacy and comfort of their home.

*"Patients are so grateful when they are able to meet with the BHUC team and receive assistance in reducing the symptoms they are experiencing without having to go to a hospital emergency room or wait months for an appointment with a mental health professional. This immediate assistance, which occurs in the privacy of their own home, transforms them from feeling hopeless to hopeful." - Dr. Kim Smith, BHUC Manager*

The tremendous benefit of a virtual program is the ability to serve anyone in Michigan needing behavioral health urgent care support - including those in rural communities, those who are home-bound and those who lack access to transportation.

The National Suicide Hotline Designation Act brought 988 to the nation in July 2022. The 988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline is a 24-hour telephone, chat and text line for people in crisis or distress. Common Ground answered the call by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services to serve and support people in crisis by becoming the primary team to answer 988 calls for all but seven counties throughout the state of Michigan.

While 988 is a network of independently operated call centers across the country, the Michigan Crisis and Access Line (MiCAL) is unique to Michigan – which celebrated their one-year anniversary in April 2022. The MiCAL crisis line answers 988 calls for 76 of the 83 counties in Michigan and serves as a backup to the remaining 7 counties.

In addition to serving as the primary service team for Michigan residents, Common Ground staff also serve people throughout the country as back-up for 988 Crisis chat and text services. While 988's primary objective is to direct calls, chats and texts to their local center, they recognized the need for the network to efficiently handle overflow from across the nation. Common Ground was selected in a competitive national process to serve as a Chat and Text backup center, helping to ensure those in crisis who reach out to the network via chat or text are served in a professional, timely and caring manner.

*"We have built an amazing team of people that deeply care to support others in crisis. When the team feels cared for, they care for others even better. # TO HOPE

Frontline Strong Together (FST5) is a statewide, 24-hour phone, chat and text line, staffed by former or current first responders and passionate civilians, to provide first responders with mental health and crisis support to police officers, fire fighters, EMS, correctional officers, and their immediate families.

*"Frontline Strong has already made a difference with a few first responders suffering with suicidal ideations, and absolutely saved lives in two situations to date. I am very proud to be a part of this and proud of those involved on the line." - Jim Peyton, Frontline Strong Together Administrator*

We anticipate an opportunity for further growth as 988 becomes more integrated and established in the coming years.

What many people may not know is that it is also a warmline to connect people with certified peer support specialists and/or recovery coaches who have lived experiences with behavioral health issues, trauma, or personal crises and are trained to support and empower callers.

*"The most humbling part of the Peer Warmline is to be able to provide emotional support to callers who know that we have been through similar situations as peers. Our callers know that they are not alone and that there is a peer on the other end that is there to listen, provide support, encouragement, and above all, hope. That is what we are all about." - Mary Beth Franks, CPSS, Peer Warmline Manager*

The Peer Warmline is operational from 10am to 2am daily to provide emotional support to callers by individuals with lived experience and who are Certified Peer Support Specialists or dually certified as Certified Peer Recovery Coaches. This line answers a little over 5,000 calls per month. The Peer Warmline is an option for those who are not in immediate crisis.

*"It has been an exciting year of growth. We have increased our staffing to meet the demand for calls across the state. We have over 100 people who provide support for 988, Frontline Strong Together, Peer Warmline, and to the Community Mental Health Service Providers in the Upper Peninsula after hours. We received incredible feedback from callers that the support they received in real time on the phone helped them move from crisis to hope." – Jill Smith, Senior Director, MiCAL*

# A YEAR OF GATHERING

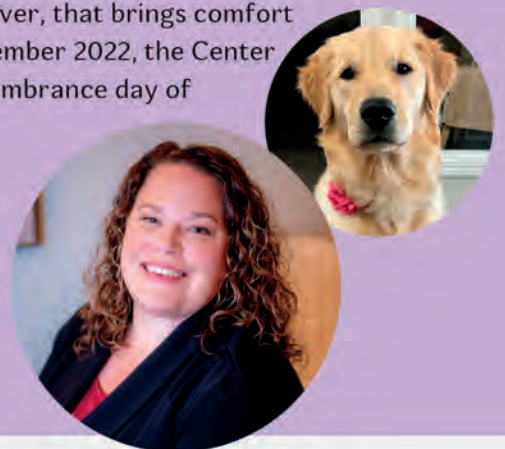


In September 2022, the All for Oxford Resiliency Center opened their doors to the Oxford community to promote mental and emotional well-being by offering a welcoming space for people to come together, find support, restore the community's sense of safety and security, and help each other heal in the aftermath of the Oxford school shooting in 2021.

The All for Oxford Resiliency Center is managed by Common Ground and funded through a Federal Anti-terrorism and Emergency Assistance Program grant. Anyone who is struggling in the aftermath of the Oxford shooting can come to the center for help and community connection - with all services being free of charge.

The staff works hard to meet each person where they are with the understanding that everyone has unique reactions to traumatic events, heals at their own pace, and that healing can take many years. In addition to drop-in, weekly activities, workshops, drinks and snacks, the Center also offers therapy dog Thursdays and has even adopted Wyleigh, an 18-month old Golden Retriever, that brings comfort and support to visitors on a regular basis. From September through December 2022, the Center served over 1,600 visitors – with over 400 of those on the one year remembrance day of the Oxford tragedy. ## RAISING FUNDS TO PROVIDE HOPE

The past year was filled with community gatherings as in-person events slowly re-emerged in communities throughout the country. In October 2021, we hosted the inaugural Celebration of Hope staff and volunteer appreciation event, followed by an evening gala in honor of Common Ground's 50th anniversary. The gala raised nearly \$80,000 to benefit the Behavioral Health Urgent Care program and honored Kay White, Board Chair, with the first annual Kay White Legacy Award.

Kicking off 2022, Jessica Scott hosted her annual Facials Against Suicide at Heavenly Day Spa in February. The event has raised funds for mental health services since 2014 and is dedicated to bringing awareness to suicide prevention and spreading kindness. As a survivor of suicide loss, Jessica has turned her personal experiences into a movement to help others heal and support one another.



February also brought the celebration of the Neiman Marcus and YAN International Lunar New Year Runway Fashion Show. The evening featured a traditional Asian dress exhibition, Asian food, a Grand Bollywood Dance Troupe performance, live painting, silent auction, and fashion presentation with an appearance by the Dragon Dancers. The event, hosted by chairs Amy Ordon, Yan Stewart, Angel Lavry and Lindsey Barile, aimed to celebrate Asian culture and raise funds and awareness for mental health.



The spring welcomed the annual Legacy of Hope breakfast in May 2022. Over 100 attendees gathered at Wabeek Club to hear the State of Common Ground address and keynote by Susie Kamen, licensed master social worker and communications expert, who shared insights about the changing mental health landscape. Funds raised from this event supported the launch of the Virtual Behavioral Health Urgent Care program.



Fall was a very busy season for events, as the Ride 2 End Suicide team hosted their 7th annual bike ride and celebration on September 10, 2022. Terri and Lou Jozefiak started the Ride 2 End Suicide after losing their beautiful daughter, Marie. Their mission is to save other families from the tragedy they experienced through generous mission gifts to Common Ground and two other organizations dedicated to suicide prevention and treatment.



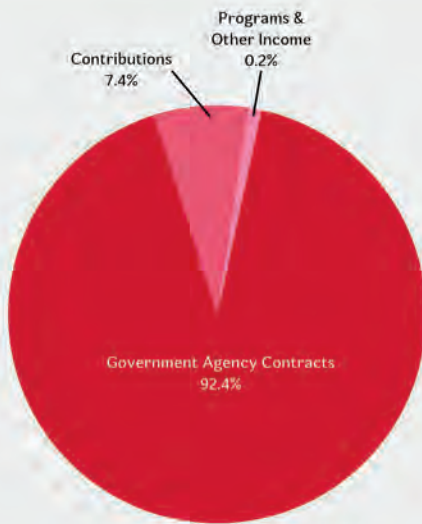
Just two weeks later, The Guild hosted the 48th annual Common Ground Birmingham Street Art Fair in Birmingham. The Art Fair showcased 100 juried artists with fine art and design pieces. Common Ground hosted an informational booth to educate the community about mental health services including the new Virtual Behavioral Health Urgent Care program, as well as the annual silent auction with items donated by art fair exhibitors. The silent auction was hosted in-person and online allowing participants to bid on items from anywhere in the world.



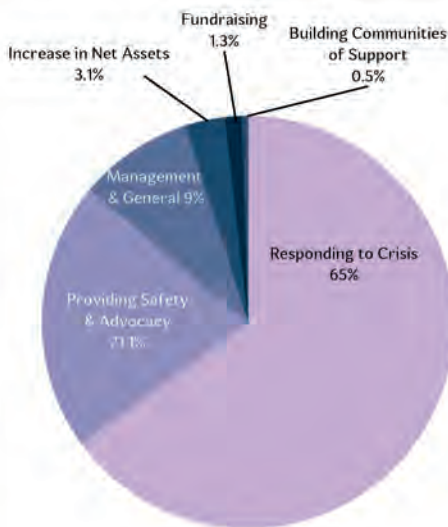

Fiscal Year 2021-22 financial results show a 17% increase in revenue over the prior year and a 24% increase in expenses. The increase in revenue and expenses is a direct result of more people served through crucial programs that are helping people move from crisis to hope. With our 988 and MiCAL programs serving over 125,000 people alone, the number of people served has increased substantially year over year.

We are incredibly grateful to our dedicated community of donors as well as funders - including Oakland Community Health Network, Genesee Health System, State of Michigan and federal grants.
